CPD services are individualized to meet each consumer's needs and include:

- Work evaluation

- Job intervention including:
 - Assistive equipment assessment
 - Accommodation recommendations
 - Disability awareness for employers
- Job readiness workshops for high school students
- Life skills assessment including:
 - Safety
 - Daily living skills
 - Adaptive equipment and training
- Support services for financially-qualified Franklin County seniors

In addition to vocational services, CPD offers community and corporate sign language classes.
