

Toddler Language Class

The Toddler Language Class (TLC) is a classroom-based speech/language therapy program developed for toddlers who are not talking as well as expected for their age.

- TLC provides opportunities for development of speech, language and oral coordination skills in a child's natural routine of play and functional activities.
- TLC is taught by a Speech Language Pathologist and a Child Development Specialist. An Occupational Therapist participates for 2 hours per week.
- TLC is a nine-month program (September through May) that meets three days a week for 2 ½ hours.

Requirements:

- Child must reside in Franklin County.
- Child must be between 20 and 30 months of age as of September of the school year enrolled.
- Child must have a diagnosis of Expressive Language Delay/Deficit.
