Provide diagnostic services to children with suspected Autism Spectrum Disorder ages 12 months to 5 yrs; 11 months.

Qualifications:

- Licensed Clinical Psychologist with a Doctor of Psychology degree (PsyD or PhD).
- Hold or be actively acquiring a license in clinical psychology from the State of Ohio.
- Must complete and provide proof of fingerprinting and background check at the onset of the professional contract.
- Organized, efficient, dedicated, and compassionate psychologist with excellent communication and collaboration skills.
- Experience in working with young children on the Autism Spectrum, including the administration and interpretation of relevant standardized tests.
- Must maintain and provide proof of valid professional liability insurance.
- Strong skills in diagnosing, treatment plan development, and making appropriate and necessary recommendations as well as the ability to problem-solve and accept feedback when circumstances warrant such actions.
- Physical requirements: must be able to lift up to 30 pounds, must be able to sit on the floor to interact with young children for extended periods of time, and must be able to move efficiently and quickly from one position to another.
